



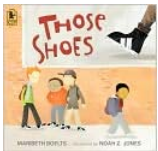

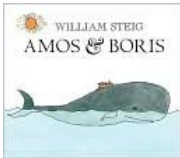
December: Kindness

***Those Shoes* by Maribeth Boelts**

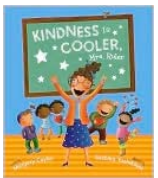
Jeremy's shoes finally are worn out—now he can get a pair of *those* shoes that are so cool! But they are too expensive. What now?

***Amos & Boris* by William Steig**

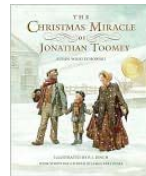
